

# Accommodation FAQ's

## What dates does my Accommodation Licence cover?

Your accommodation licence covers term-time only. You are required to fully vacate your room over the Christmas and Easter vacations as the rooms are used for conferences.

Michaelmas Term Accommodation: 07/10/2025 - 06/12/2025

Hilary Term Accommodation: 13/01/2026 - 14/03/2026

Trinity Term Accommodation: 21/04/2026 - 20/06/2026

# I have exams that take place after the end of term?

If you have an exam taking place in 9<sup>th</sup> Week you are entitled to College accommodation, although this may be in a different room. Please speak to the Head of Accommodation Services by the end of 4<sup>th</sup> week of each term to confirm this.

### Can I leave anything in my room over the vacation?

All rooms must be left empty over the vacations so that they can be used for conferences. Most rooms have lockable storage available in them, please place any items you wish to leave in these storage areas. Your Scout will then lock these after you depart and open them up again for you when you come up for the following term.

#### Can I stay in College over the vacation?

We have a limited number of rooms available over the Christmas and Easter vacations. These will be prioritised for any international students wishing to remain and are charged separately to your accommodation licence. Please speak to the Head of Accommodation Services by the end of 4<sup>th</sup> week of each term to confirm this.

## What should I bring with me?

All College rooms are supplied with the following:

- Bed, mattress protector, duvet, pillow
- Bedside table
- Desk and desk chair
- Armchair
- Desk lamp
- Rin
- Chest of drawers and/or wardrobe
- Window and floor coverings

The College does not supply bedlinen. Remember, though – anything you bring with you at the beginning of term must be taken away with you at the end.



# Are there laundry facilities?

Yes, the College has 2 laundry rooms, one in the Levine Building and one in Dolphin Yard. These are operated by Circuit Laundry.

## What is my postal address?

All students have a pige (pigeonhole) at the Lodge which is open 24 hours/day. Your postal address is therefore Trinity College, Broad Street, Oxford, Oxon, OX1 3BH.

#### When will I find out what room I have been allocated?

You will be invited to apply for accommodation via our online portal once you receive your SSO from central IT Services. Rooms will then be allocated by the start of October. Please ensure you login to the portal to view your allocation and complete the online induction before you arrive.

### Is there a Gym in College?

The College Gym is located in Dolphin Yard and is available free of charge. There is a mixture of cardio and weights equipment. You must have an induction prior to access being granted.

#### What are Scouts?

Your Scout helps you to keep your room clean. They work Monday – Friday and will introduce themselves to you during 0<sup>th</sup> week.

#### Will I share my room with someone else?

No, all Undergraduate Fresher rooms are single occupancy. You may choose to live in a 2-person set in your second year via the JCR Ballot

#### How much is the rent per term?

All rooms at Trinity are the same price. The Bursary will be in touch to explain how the payment process works and will be able to let you know the current cost per term, you can also view this on the accommodation portal.

#### What do I need to do on coming up day (arrivals day)

You will be able to collect your keys from 10:00 on the 7<sup>th</sup> October 2025. We are fortunate to have limited parking in College – please come to the front gates and the Porters will direct you.

In order to ensure that all students are able to unload their belongings we would ask that you only leave your car on site for a maximum of 20 minutes. Please then park outside of College. There are multiple car parks in the vicinity – the Westgate multi-storey car park will likely have the most spaces.
