Dining	Dinner in the Dining Hall ranges from self-service to Formal Hall. Self-service: For self-service meals (please see below for applicable meals) you can just turn up and pay at the till point. Formal Hall: You need to book in advance for formal hall via this link: https://food.trinity.ox.ac.uk. You should sign up before 10am the day of the dinner, except in the case of Friday Guest Night and Sunday Chapel Formal Hall for which you should sign up to <u>10am the day before</u>. All Members should wear academic gowns for Formal Hall and Guest Nights and should be suitably dressed for all other informal meals. If you are not signed up, are late for meals, or not suitably dressed, you may be refused entry but will still be charged. Remember to put money on your university card in advance for meals in Hall!
